**Sub: Establishment of Department of Computer Science and Information Technology.**

There have been representations from different quarters including the students of the University to introduce Post Graduate Diploma courses in Computer Applications (PGDCA) and Information Technology (PGDIT). At present the University does not have Departments of Computer Science and Information Technology. To introduce the courses in Computer Science and Information Technology the department has to be established. Hence the Vice Chancellor has approved it under Section 11 (3) of the University Act. The proposed amendment to Statues 39 the University is placed at **Annexure - V**.

**Sub: Introduction of new courses.**

The University proposes to introduce following new courses, in campus regular mode from the academic year 2006-07.

- a. M.A in Public Administration (Four Semester)
- b. M.A. in Social Work (Four Semester)
- c. P. G. Diploma in Modern Arabic (Two Semester)
- d. P.G. Diploma in Modern Persian (Two Semester)

The standing committee of the Academic Council approved the introduction of these four courses through campus mode in its meeting held on 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2006.
