**Sub: Introduction of Diploma in Polytechnic Programs for new Polytechnics to be established at Kadapa, Andhra Pradesh and Cuttack, Odisha - Reg.**

The University established Polytechnics at Hyderabad, Darbhanga, and Bengaluru from the Academic Year 2008-09. There is a considerable demand for Diploma Programs offered by the Polytechnics in view of immediate placement after completion of Diploma as also for pursuing higher education. The Diploma holders have the option of lateral entry for admission to B. Tech. Programs. This program is also a Skill based programme, which is a focus of the Government of India as it envisions to develop India as a Skilled force supplier for the world.

In view of the demand for Polytechnics from various quarters, the University proposes through Academic Section to start Polytechnic Programs for new Polytechnics to be established at Kadapa, Andhra Pradesh and Cuttack, Odisha from the Academic Year 2018-19.

Sub: **Approval of Establishment of Polytechnic at Kadappa (Andhra Pradesh) and Polytechnic and Industrial Training Institute (ITI) at Cuttack (Odisha). - regarding.**

Sir,

With reference to the letter No. MANUU/P&D/F.01/2016-17/102 dated 27-03-2017 & No. MANUU/P&D/F.94/2016-17/101 dated 27-03-2017 on the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that the MHRD vide its letter No. F.27-7/2016-CU-I dated 21-02-2017 & No. F.27-4/2015-Desk U dated 20-02-2017 has conveyed the concurrence for establishment of Polytechnic at Kadappa (Andhra Pradesh) and Polytechnic and Industrial Training Institute (ITI) at Cuttack (Odisha). To assess the proposal of the University for their financial requirement and approval of courses, UGC constituted an Expert Committee for this purpose. The recommendation of the Committee was placed before the Commission in its 525<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 4<sup>th</sup> September, 2017. The Commission approved the recommendations of the Expert Committee.

On the basis of the recommendation of the Committee and as approved by the Commission, I am to convey the approval of the UGC for establishment of Polytechnic at Kadappa and Polytechnic and Industrial Training Institute (ITI) at Cuttack as per details below:-

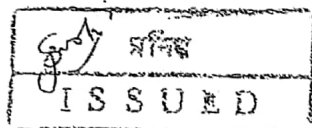

In addition to above, an amount of Rs. 50.00 lakhs per annum recurring expenditure of the polytechnic and ITI at Cuttack for maintenance, contingencies, utilities, transit office and hiring of one vehicle for the campus and for Director Incharge / OSD of the Campus is approved. The recurring expenditure will be allocated by UGC separately under the recurring head of the university.

The above approval is subject to the fulfilling of the following conditions:-

- (i) The University may strictly adhere the reservation policy for SC/ST/OBC/PH as per Government of India guidelines while filling up the teaching and non-teaching positions.
- (ii) University may follow the norms and standards of the AICTE/ NCVT for the professional courses to be started in Polytechnic and Industrial Training Institute (ITI).
- (iii) The qualification for teaching and technical staff may be prescribed as per AICTE/NCVT/UGC norms as the case may be. For other administrative positions, the qualification may be prescribed as per UGC/Govt. of India norms.
- (iv) The University may fill up the Non-teaching posts after revising the existing Recruitment Rules in pursuance of the UGC letter No.F.69-4/2012 (CU) dated 14<sup>th</sup> August, 2015.
