Item No. 12.2: Adopting AICTE Model Curriculum of B.Tech (Computer Science) wef academic year 2018-2019

In view of AICTE designed Model Curriculum for Undergraduate Degree Courses in Engineering & Technology January 2018, Department of CS&IT has adopted AICTE Model Curriculum for B.Tech (Computer Science) with effective from academic year 2018-19. Accordingly, a student has to undergo three-weeks induction program after joining the institute and before the commencement of classes. Normal classes of the B.Tech (Computer Science) program shall begin after the students have

undergone a three-weeks induction program. The Induction program for students comprises of Physical activities; Learning an art form; Literature & Cinema; Social Awareness; Lectures & Visits; Universal Human Values; Familiarization to Department/Branch, College & Innovations. **Annexure-1**
Item No. 12.3: To discontinue exit option for PGDIT and M.Sc (IT) in MCA program admission with effective from 2018-19.

It is observed that applicants for admission in MCA program are increasing rapidly every year and the employability factor of MCA students is higher in terms of requirement and pursuing higher study. After successful completion of MCA course, students are with multiple skill sets including system designing, system administration, and computer networks, to data mining, warehousing, enterprise resource planning, and application software development.
