## **Centre for the Study of Social Exclusion and Inclusive Policy (CSSEIP)**

### **Progress Report (1<sup>st</sup> April 2009 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2010)**

The Centre for the Study of Social Exclusion and Inclusive Policy (CSSEIP) is established at Maulana Azad National Urdu University (MANUU) – Hyderabad. Its' key objectives include contextualizing and problematizing, while conceptualizing, the exclusion and inclusion existed on the lines of caste/ethnicity and religion, in the society. It also plays a key role in suggesting policy formulations aiming at eradicating the problem of social exclusion and discrimination and protecting the rights of these groups. The CSSEIP has acclaimed its' existence as one of the few such Centres started in India following the UGC's initiative to establish and promote the Centres for study of Social Exclusion and Inclusive Policy during X Plan. Its activities include, teaching, research and action oriented programmes in collaboration with the reputed bodies working in the areas of social development among the socially excluded groups.

Therefore the UGC has identified the Maulana Azad National Urdu University as one of the universities to set up a centre for the Study of Social Exclusion and Inclusive Policy (CSSEIP) to study the nature, extent and forms of social exclusion among some selective socially excluded groups at present and to suggest theoretical and policy formulations in this regard. The main thrust area of this Centre for the Study of Social Exclusion and Inclusive Policy (CSSEIP) is studying religious minorities with specific focus upon the Muslims as a socially excluded group, exclusion of Urdu speaking population, while studying the other excluded groups such as dalits and tribes.

### **One Day Seminar:**

CSSEIP in collaboration with the Young Lives India has organized a ‘One Day Seminar’ on “Childhood Poverty in the context of Social Exclusion” on 23-07-2009. The seminar was focused on the findings of the Young Lives research based two Rounds of its’ survey data. In this seminar the processes of Childhood Poverty and the action initiated thereupon to tackle the menace, has been debated. Findings from other researches on poverty in the context of Social Exclusion in India are also presented and discussed. Prof. S. K. Galab, Fellow at the Centre for Economic and Social Studies (CESS) Hyderabad was presented as the key resource person for this workshop.

### **Field Visit:**

CSSEIP has conducted a one-day field exposure tour to the M.Phil research students in the Charminar area of Hyderabad on 16-12-2009. The main aim of this programme was to inculcate the fieldwork techniques among the research students in a way to train them to take up research activities independently. The Confederation of Voluntary Associations (COVA) a well-known NGO working towards capacity building among the Muslim minorities and the communal harmony, has facilitated the CSSEIP members in carrying out the fieldwork. The areas like Mehtarwadi, Sultan Shahi, etc., were selected for the field work in the locality. The observations as narrated by the students in their reports on the concerned/given topics assume significance from social exclusion point of view. For example, the reports revealed that some of the members belonging to the scavenging communities, were involved in their traditional occupation of scavenging

even today. The reports of the visit sought that the local bodies like Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation (GHMC) should directly assign the cleaning work pertaining to government buildings in Hyderabad, instead of involving them through contractors who exploit the scavenging communities by making a low wages to scavengers.

The team of MPhil students visited a Talabkatta and collected research data on the on the availability of public resources and the lack of access to them to the poor and marginal Muslims. This highlighted the social exclusion of the Muslim communities in Hyderabad. They express their concern over the negligence of civic amenities in old part of the city like clean drinking water, sanitation and health services. They express their unhappiness over the exploitation of poor Muslims by local moneylenders. The field reports sought government to provide good schools with a infrastructure and quality education to inculcate interest among the parents to send their children to schools and to promote education among the Muslims.

M. Phil research students team has visited Hafizbabanagar area and to dwell upon the issues governing the Self Help Groups formed by the women and promoted by the NGOs and the government. It is noted that the SHG formed by the Muslim women in this locality are involoved in the *Carchobi* and Embroidery work and bank upon these activities to generate income thus these activities promoting the women empowerment among the Muslims. However, the members concern for more government help and cooperation of the local banks is really a matter of concern for everybody.

The faculty members of the CSSEIP accompanied the students and given their academic support during the visit.

**Visiting Faculty:**

CSSEIP had invited Prof. Noor Mohammad - who is a senior faculty and the Head of the department of Sociology and Social Work in 'Aligarh Muslim University' (AMU) - as a visiting faculty for five days from 21-25 Dec. 2009. Prof. Noor Mohammad has attended the five days academic programmes schedule as assigned to him by the CSSEIP and dwelled upon following topics: Social Exclusion, Field experiences, Child & Women

Health. And also suggested to identify the new area of research and prepared a precise agenda of research particularly covering the problems of Muslim minority in AP in particular and India in general. Students and the faculty members have been actively participated in this activity.

### **National Conference:**

CSSEIP organized a three days National Conference on “Exclusionary Perspectives for Muslims & Marginalized groups” from 22-24 Feb. 2010. Dr. Amirullah Khan, Research Director & Dean of Bangalore Management Academy, Bangalore, was invited as the Chief Guest in the Inaugural Session. The eminent Sociologist Prof. T.K Oommen has given the Keynote Address. Prof. Imtiaz Ahmed, Prof. Mohammad Shabir, Prof. Anant Giri, Prof. Abhijit Das Gupta, & Prof. Noor Mohammad were among the prominent scholars who participated in the Conference as the recourse persons. Prof. T.K. Oommen, in his keynote address, has pointed out that the Muslim community in India has really become a marginalized community due to innumerable factors and are pushed to the lower ebb of development stage. He suggested that the Muslim should be given due share in recognition of their language and culture particularly promotion of Urdu at primary and secondary level. In valedictory Session Dr. S.M. Ilyas, Former Director NAARM, Hyderabad was the Chief Guest and he emphasized that Muslim students should prepare themselves to face the stiff competition of today’s marketing economy. He further advised the students to develop their talent in a right direction and fetch more technical skills through formal professional degrees of Universities and Institutions. Prof. Nancharyah, Former VC, Bhim Rao Ambedkar University; Lucknow and presently Dean of Social Sciences, University of Hyderabad, supported the extension of reservation facilities to minority students to improve their educational qualifications. This affirmative action will certainly bring them on equal footing in present day economic development. The CSSEIP has mobilized part of funding from the Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR), New Delhi, Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR), Southern Regional Centre, Hyderabad, also, besides the CSSEIP’s own budget.

There was a tremendous response to our call for papers. We had received more than 150 abstracts and we selected about 100 of the good papers and finally 120 papers have been finalized for the presentation in the conference and I must tell you that we had a tough time in selecting the paper as we deemed all that what we had received were fit for their presentation. But since we had to down size it we had to call up certain papers. The whole event has been organized into 12 technical sessions putting them into 10 sessions and another major session, i.e., symposium by Prof. Imtiaz Ahmed. We received participants across all over the country, particularly, AMU, JMI, JNU, in New Delhi, HCU, NIRD, OU and other universities in Andhra Pradesh.
