Items for Consideration

16.5. To consider the updation of the curriculum of B. Tech.(CS), MCA, M.Tech(CS), and PhD. Programmes as per LOCF w.e.f. academic year 2022-23.

The BoS discussed the curriculum in detail and approved the updated curriculum of B. Tech.(CS). MCA, M.Tech(CS), and PhD. Programmes as per LOCF w.e.f. academic year 2022-23. It is resolved that the suggestion received from members may be incorporated and curriculum may be placed in School Board for final approval. (Annexure-5)

16.6. To consider the introduction of the mandatory internship for B.Tech.(CS) & MCA Programmes.

The BoS was with the opinion that mandatory internship will equip the students with practical understanding and provide them exposure to real time industrial environments. Further, BoS deliberated and discussed all the aspects of the introduction of the mandatory internship for B.Tech.(CS) & MCA Programmes and resolved the following:

- The mandatory internship shall be applicable for the B.Tech.(CS) students admitted in the academic year 2021-22 or later; and MCA students admitted in the academic year 2022-23 or later.
- 2. There is a necessary condition that at least 3-4 weeks non-credit mandatory internship shall be completed by B.Tech.(CS) & MCA students for the award of the degree.
- 3. Internship may be done in physical or virtual mode during the summer/winter vacation. However, virtual internship may be done along with courses, if it doesn't affect the Theory/Lab attendance of the students.
- 16.7. To introduce 4 credits Open Elective (Generic Electives) course titled "Introduction to Cyber Crime, Safety & Law" as approved in

 15^{th} BOS in the Odd semester for Graduates & Post Graduates students of $3^{rd}/5^{th}$ semester.

The BoS approved the introduction of 4 credits Open Elective (Generic Electives) course titled "Introduction to Cyber Crime. Safety & Law". This course may be offered by the Department of CS & IT for Graduates & Post Graduates students of 3rd/5th semester w.e.f. from academic year 2023-24; subject to availability of the minimum number of students and availability of the teaching faculty. (Annexure-6)

16.8. To consider the external evaluation of 8th semester Project of B. Tech (CS) Programme equivalent to external evaluation of MCA final semester Major Project.

The BoS observed that existing norms [Notification issued by Examination Branch dated 4th May, 2012] for payment of Honorarium/Remuneration for conduction of Semester End Examination of Regular mode courses were not completely defined in respect of courses offered by Dept. of CS & IT. The existing norms were issued common to all the regular mode Degree/P.G/Ph.D courses and the same were adopted for all the Practical (Lab) Examinations of CS &IT. The nature of evaluation of Final semester Project is different from regular practical Lab Examination and it is not justified to evaluate final semester projects of all the students by one examiner in one day.

In view of the above, BoS recommends that external evaluation of 8th semester Project of B. Tech (CS) Programme shall be treated equivalent to external evaluation of MCA final semester Major Project. However, in case of B. Tech (CS), maximum number of 8th semester projects that may be evaluated by one external examiner in one day, shall be 10.

The BoS also recommends that existing norms for payment of Honorarium/Remuneration for conduction of Semester End Examination of Regular mode courses shall be revised by the competent authority as it was defined more than 10 years back. (Annexure-7)
