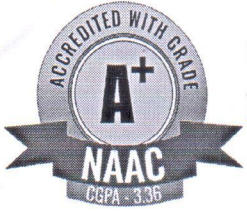

The agenda for the 15th School Board was as follows:

15.1 To seek confirmation of the minutes of the 14th School Board meeting held on **06th April 2023** and to apprise about the progress of the Department of Mass Communication and Journalism till date.

15.2 To seek approval of B.A. (Hons.) JMC and B.A. (Hons. With Research) course with Dual Major 4 Year Program course under the Curriculum and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programmes– 2023 as per National Educational Policy (NEP) 2020.

15.3 In view of the MOU between IIMC and MANUU dated 05th May, 2022, it is proposed that students who have completed their P.G. Diploma in Urdu Journalism as well as other students of P.G. Diploma in Journalism from the Indian Institute of Mass Communication (IIMC), New Delhi or any

other of it's Centre may be eligible for 'Lateral Entry' admission into M.A. (JMC) 2nd year offered by the Department of Mass Communication and Journalism, MANUU, Hyderabad.

15.4 Any other item with the permission of the Chair.

The resolution of the 15th School Board is as follows:

The Dean, School of JMC has appraised the members on the progress of the School of Mass Communication and Journalism to date.

15.1 The members of the School Board have confirmed the minutes of the 14th Board of Studies meeting held on **06th April 2023**.

15.2. The members of the School Board have approved B.A.(Hons.)JMC and B.A.(Hons. With Research) course with a Dual Major under the Curriculum Framework for Undergraduate Programmes as per the National Educational Policy (NEP) 2020.

15.3. To achieve one of the objectives of MOU between IIMC and MANUU, the School Board has approved the 'Lateral Entry' admission for the students who have completed 'P.G. Diploma in Urdu Journalism' as well as other 'P.G. Diploma in Journalism' course run by Indian Institute of Mass Communication (IIMC), New Delhi or any other of its Centre into 2nd year of M.A.(JMC) course offered by the Department of Mass Communication and Journalism, MANUU, Hyderabad. The members of the ^{SB} BOS have approved that the students who have obtained 'A P.G. Diploma in Journalism' from IIMC may be also eligible for 'Lateral Entry' admission into 2nd Year of M.A.(JMC) course offered by the Department of Mass Communication and Journalism, MANUU, Hyderabad if the student have studied 'Urdu' as one of the subjects in 10th/10+2/Graduation level. Further, the members of the ^{SB} BOS have approved the following conditions for 'Lateral Entry' admission into 2nd Year of the M.A. JMC course:

- The intake of 'P.G. Diploma in Urdu Journalism' / 'P.G. Diploma in Journalism' students of IIMC in 2nd Year of M.A.(JMC) will be **Ten (10)** over and above the existing intake of M.A.(JMC) course.
- The student who has passed the 'P.G. Diploma in Urdu Journalism' from IIMC will be given an extra weightage of **5% Marks** while preparing the merit list for 'Lateral Entry' admissions into the M.A.(JMC) course during 2nd Year.

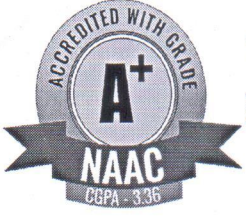

- e) The admissions of 'Lateral Entry' into 2nd year of M.A.(JMC) will be commenced from academic year 2024-25.
