**CIRCULAR**

**Sub: G-20 University Connect Programme – Reg.**

**Ref: 1) Advisory issued by the Secretary, UGC, dated 23-01-2023,  
2) Approval of the Vice-Chancellor, dated 27-03-2023.**

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India has taken over the G-20 Presidency on 01.02.2022, in view of this an Advisory issued by the Secretary, University Grants Commission in connection with G-20 University Connect Programme. The '**G-20 University Connect Programme**' aims to project our youth as cultural ambassadors who can build long-lasting relationship with G-20 fraternity. This will be an opportunity for young Indians to bring new ideas and perspectives related to the G-20 theme. It has been decided by the government that higher education institutions across the country shall organize special programmes on G-20 themes starting from January upto September, 2023.

In compliance of the Advisory issued by the Secretary, University Grants Commission, it has been decided to organize a series of various programmes/events/activities by the various Schools / Departments of the University. As per the Advisory issued by the UGC, numerous events/activities on a variety of topics may be undertaken related to the history, culture, and legacy of the area. Some of them are enlisted as follows:

- *Routine / pre scheduled events of the institutions like convocation, annual days, sporting events, seminars etc. should be branded as G-20 event.*
- *Logos, posters, standees of G-20 should be displayed on the campus and all events of the institution. The open file for the design is being shared.*
- *Special events including seminars, quiz, painting, crossword, declamation, marathon, cycling marathon, Insta-Reel and other completions, sporting events, youth camps, model G-20 etc. can be organized on G-20 related themes at the institution and state levels with a grand finale in September at the national level.*
- *RIS (Resource & Information Centre for Developing Countries) is organizing seminars at 75 universities.*
- *All Higher Education Institutions should organize similar seminars on G-20 themes based on template.*
- *All institutions to undertake regular Swachhta Campaign in and around their respective campuses as part of G-20 event.*
- *G-20 T-Shirts, Caps, Wrist Bands, G-20 Badges can be distributed to participating students and to NSS/NYKS volunteers.*
- *The celebrations will culminate in a grand even in September in which there can be prize distribution of competitions, Jazz/Band/NCC Parade on G-20.*
- *Institutions may ensure maximum community participation in these events.*
- *In addition to the aforementioned activities, the University can take up any other activity or event related to G-20 theme.*

The above committee will review time to time the programmes/events/activities organized by the various departments of the University and also give suggestions about the programmes/events/activities to be organized by the various departments of the University.

The following actions are to be taken under the **G-20 University Connect programme**:

1. Each and every Department / School shall undertake at least 3 programmes/events/activities every month from the aforementioned list of the activities. Awareness Lectures on G-20 may be organized by the academic departments and various activities may be conducted by NSS and NCC.
2. **G-20 logo** should be invariably displayed under all the programme/events/activities organized by the academic and other departments or coordinators.
3. PRO Section shall ensure wide coverage of the programmes/events/activities organized by the various schools and departments of the University in various print and electronic media.
4. International Media Center shall upload the programmes/events/activities organised by the various schools and departments of the University on the social media. IMC, MANUU may plan screening of documentaries and movies related to G-20 theme, '**Vasudhav Kutumbkam**' (वसुधैव कुटुंबकम).
5. CIT, MANUU shall ensure that **G-20 logo** should be flashed regularly on the LED screen installed at the entrance of the University.



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6. NSS Coordinator shall arrange to place banners of **G-20 logo** at the University Gates and in front of the Administrative Building.
7. The Placement In-Charge offered to arrange T-Shirts (50 Nos.), Caps (50 Nos.) and Badges (100 Nos.) printed with G-20 logos for providing to the students participating in the programmes/events/activities related to G-20.
8. **Grand finale** along with Cuisine and Dresses of G-20 countries may be organized before September, 2023.

After organizing the programmes/events/activities successfully, the concerned Department / School shall send a write up, along with photographs and videos to the Planning & Development Section through email for the purpose of uploading on the concerned portal.
