With reference to Agenda Item No. 2 regarding the syllabus for the Ph.D course work in Deccan Studies, the Advisory Committee has approved the syllabus of all the three papers. As per the suggestion made by Prof. Saneem Fatima, Dean Academics, Paper 2 and Paper 3 have been interchanged and the latest paper structure is as mentioned below.* The title of the fourth paper is revised as **Research Publication and Ethics** in the place of Research Ethics. This paper will be taught by the librarian, MANUU as is being done for the entire university.

Prof. Saneem Fatima, Dean Academics, recommended that the number of units in Paper II and Paper III should be four (04) instead of five (05) and accordingly the syllabus will be reorganised and the same will be informed to the members of the Advisory Committee. Prof. Azizuddin Husain was of the view that the Ph.D scholars who will be admitted into Ph.D in Deccan Studies should be offered an exclusive paper in source languages of the Deccan especially Persian. The Director, H.K.Sherwani Centre for Deccan Studies said that the scholars registered for Ph.D in Deccan Studies can be asked to enrol for the Diploma in Persian which is already being offered by the Dept. of Persian, MANUU.

With reference to Agenda Item No. 3 regarding the constitution of a Research Advisory Committee (RAC) for the H.K.Sherwani Centre for Deccan Studies Ph.D program, the members of the Advisory Committee were of the view that the RAC should be constituted from among the faculty of the Centre for Deccan Studies with the Director, HKSCDS as the Chairperson. As such the RAC of H.K.Sherwani Centre for Deccan Studies will be structured as follows:

With reference to Agenda Item No. 4 regarding two faculty members from the Directorate of Distance Education to be co-opted as research supervisors at the Centre for Deccan Studies, it was appraised to the Advisory Committee by the Dean Academics that Prof. Nikhat Jahan's (Urdu, DDE) and Dr. Mahboob Basha's (History, DDE) vacancy intake for Ph.D candidates has already been notified in the Prospectus 2022-23 in the departments of Urdu and History respectively. Thus, it was decided that in case there is special requirement of their specialisation in Centre for Deccan Studies, then they can be taken as co-supervisors only. Hence, the Ph.D intake of HKSCDS for the Academic Year 2022-23 is as follows:

With reference to the Agenda Item No. 5 regarding the two Orders related to Ph.D Regulations, external member Prof. Muzaffar Ali Shahmeeri, and the faculty of the Centre for Deccan Studies felt that the latter Order dated 13th March 2020 given by the Academic

Section should prevail over the earlier Ph.D Regulations amended in 2017 and 2018. Prof. Muzaffar Ali Shahmeeri categorically wanted to know whether the amendments in Ph.D regulations made by MANUU in 2017 and 2018 are according to the UGC Regulations of Ph.D.

With reference to Agenda Item No. 6 regarding Ph.D admission during Winter Session under Self Financing Scheme, the Advisory Committee approved the same and accordingly it will be forwarded to the Academic Council for further necessary action on the same lines adopted by the Schools of Sciences, CS&IT and Management and Commerce.

With reference to Agenda Item No. 7, the Advisory Committee approved the engaging of one contractual faculty (Assistant Professor) at H.K. Sherwani Centre for Deccan Studies as there is presently a vacancy of Assistant Professor in the Centre.

With reference to the Agenda Item No. 8, the Advisory Committee unanimously agreed that the generic paper will be introduced in even Semester IV.

With reference to the Agenda Item No. 9, the Advisory Committee approved that the Centre will be signing an MoU with the Society for Indian Ocean Studies (SIOS) for academic collaboration. Prof. Muzaffar Ali Shahmeeri also requested the Centre to consider signing an MoU with Indira Gandhi National Institute of Arts (IGNIA) for digitisation of manuscripts.

It was also recommended that the Deccan Heritage Club may be revived once the vacant position of the Assistant Professor HKSCDS is filled as lot of logistics have to be arranged for the activities of the Club.

The members were also reported about the Fulbright Global Research Scholar Prof. Betul Basaran who is attached to H.K. Sherwani Centre for Deccan Studies and they also could meet her at the Centre.

The meeting ended at 1:30 pm with the member-convenor thanking everyone present in the meeting.
