Thomas Robert Mathues (1766 1834) called the father of modern population study. He discussed the impact of growing population on the progress and prosperity of the nation. Several attempts have been made to define population education but no commonly accepted concept has emerged. Perhaps this difficulty has arisen an account of three reasons.

Scope of Population Education in India

India is a big developing country. Every sixth person of the world is an Indian. Thus, India became only the second country in the world in population after China. India will beat China in 2050 with respect to (1.9%) annual growth rate of population. Only 31% Indian people using adequate sanitary facilities and 17% peoples of India are living without shelter and the birth and death ratio in India is 25 at front of 9 respectively. Only 65.38% literate persons living in India. While literacy and education are the two vary important indicators of the development of a country. Higher literacy level of the population act as a catalyst for cultural, economic, political and social development.

Our Indian constitution guarantees full freedom to all citizens irrespective of color, caste, creed and sex. One thing is clear and universally accepted that education for all at all levels and ages are the only remedy to develop our motherland in every era. Population education fulfils all the national demands and directed it into resource able elements.
