1. One day National Seminar titled: “Maulana Azad aur Qaumi Ekta” was organised by MANUU Lucknow campus on 11<sup>th</sup> November 2017, on the occasion of the birth anniversary of Maulana Azad. Renowned academicians and scholars like Professor Muhammad Muzammil former Vice Chancellor, University of Ruhelkhand and Agra, Professor S P Singh Vice Chancellor, University of Lucknow, professor Mahrukh Mirza Vice Chancellor of Urdu Arabi-Farsi University expressed their views. The keynote address was delivered by Professor Rizwan Qaisar of Jamia Millia Islamia.
2. A two-day national seminar was organised by MANUU Lucknow campus on 13 & 14 March 2018 on the title: “Autobiography: Art and Tradition”. The seminar was inaugurated on March 13, 2018 by the Honourable Vice Chancellor Dr Mohammad Aslam Parvaiz. The keynote address was delivered by Professor A R Kidwai of Aligarh Muslim University, while Dr S P Singh, the Vice Chancellor of Lucknow University participated in the seminar as chief guest. Director of the seminar and in-charge of the Campus Dr Abdul Quddoos welcomed the participants. Valuable papers were presented in the seminar by renowned scholars from different parts of the country. The valedictory session of the seminar was held on March 14, 2018, and was jointly presided over by the prominent writer Professor Zafar Ahmed Siddiqui of Aligarh Muslim University, and renowned scholar Professor Khalid Mehmood of Jamia Millia Islamia. Teachers, scholars and students in large number from the campus as well as from other Institutions of the city participated and presented their papers in the seminar.
