The resolution of the 12th Board of Studies is as follows:

12.1 The Chairman of School Board apprised about action taken regarding previous School Board held on 12th March 2020.

12.2 The members of School Board has been and briefed by the Chairman of School Board about the progress made by the School of Mass Communication and Journalism till date.

12.3 The members of the School Board approved the minor corrections/ updates carried out in existing syllabus of the M.A. (JMC) and the B.A. (Honors) JMC. Prof. Sanjay Dwivedi has suggested that the **Media Literacy** shall be also included in any one of the existing papers M.A. (JMC) and the B.A. (Honors) JMC. The other members have also opined that Media Literacy shall be added as one unit in any one of the existing papers M.A. (JMC) and the B.A. (Honors) JMC. Therefore, it has been decided that the same may be incorporated in the existing papers of 'History of Media' of M.A. (JMC) syllabus and 'Introduction to Journalism' paper of B.A. (Honors) JMC offered during First Semester.

12.4 The Chairman of the School Board has informed the committee members that due to COVID-19 Pandemic, the practical exercises related to online/studio based production for the paper - Television and Video Production Practical's for the students of M.A. (JMC) 3rd semester of academic year (2019-21) has not been completed by the students yet having weightage of four (4) credits.

The members of the School Board has informed that the hands on training for Television and Video Production essentially requires physical presence of the students to complete their assignments as part of the curriculum, which was not possible to provide it through online mode. Therefore, the members of the School Board has approved to shift the paper - Television and Video Production Practical's paper from of M.A. (JMC) 3rd Semester to M.A. (JMC) 4th Semester for the 2019-21 batch only, so that, online/studio based production exercises may be held before/after end of the semester examination of May/June-2021.
