13.1 To seek confirmation of the minutes of 12<sup>th</sup> School Board meeting held on 19.03.2021 and to apprise about the progress of the School of Mass Communication and Journalism till date.

13.2 To seek ratification regarding updates made in the syllabus of B.A. (Hons.) JMC and M.A. (JMC), as approved by BOS.

13.3 The members of the School Board has approved to start the Self-Finance Course in Ph.D. (JMC) from mid semester of 2022-2023 new academic year 2023-2024.
