Greetings from National Law School of India University, Bengaluru!

NLSIU has released a call for admissions for its **3-Year LL.B. (Hons.) programme** and **2-Year Master's Programme in Public Policy**. These postgraduate programmes are open to graduates and final year students from all disciplines. Admission to our **Ph.D. programmes in Law, and Interdisciplinary Studies** is also open.

We request you to share this letter and the enclosed poster with your students, alumni, and other networks, and encourage them to apply to these programmes.

For your information, NLSIU was established in 1986, to pioneer legal education reforms, and to anchor the transformation of the Indian legal system through research and policy interventions. For over thirty years now, the University has remained a leader in the field of legal education in the country. It has been ranked **the No. 1 law school in India in every NIRF ranking till date**.

NLSIU has recently launched a new postgraduate **3-year LL.B (Hons.) degree programme** open to graduates from any discipline. This programme offers a professional law degree, approved by the Bar Council of India, which qualifies graduates for admission to legal practice. Building on NLSIU's legacy as a pioneer in legal education, the programme is designed to provide a unique, inter-disciplinary and experiential education that will prepare students to use law to address contemporary challenges in diverse walks of social and political life.

NLSIU also has a **2-year Master's Programme in Public Policy**. Introduced in 2014, this programme provides comprehensive training, with a multidisciplinary orientation, for designing and evaluating public policies that address complex societal problems. The programme combines reflective learning through classroom discussions with in-field exposure, the experience of solving problems for real-world clients, as well as internship and research dissertation components.

NLSIU's **Ph.D. (Law) and Ph. D. (Interdisciplinary) programmes** provide an opportunity to teach or participate in ongoing research at NLSIU and contribute to the academic field in areas related to the candidate's dissertation.

Admission to these programmes will be through an All-India admission test (the NLSAT) on April 29-30, 2023. **The LL.B. (Hons.) and MPP programmes are open to applicants with an undergraduate degree in any discipline.** Students in the final year of their Bachelor's degree are also eligible to apply.
